Southbound Highway 101 Traffic Collision Fatality-Identity Released

The decedent has been positively identified as:

Isidro CERVANTES CUEVAS, a 22-year-old male from Santa Rosa, CA.

On Saturday, April 22, 2022, at approximately 03:38AM, a motor vehicle collision was reported to 9-1-1 to have occurred on Southbound Highway 101 just north of the Bellam Blvd/Francisco Blvd. exit, in San Rafael involving two motor vehicles First Responders were immediately dispatched to the area and upon their arrival at the scene, located two vehicles, which had collided head-on. Preliminary investigation suggests Mr. Cervantes Cuevas was, for unknown reasons that remain under investigation, driving northbound at highway speeds on the southbound side of Highway 101 when he struck another vehicle traveling in the southbound direction head on. Both vehicles sustained significant damage in the collision, and the driver of the other vehicle was transported to a nearby hospital for additional care. Mr. Cervante Cuevas, who was the sole occupant of his vehicle, was discovered unconscious, unresponsive, and in cardiac arrest within his vehicle post impact. Due to the extent of his injuries, resuscitative measures were not warranted, and he was pronounced deceased at the scene.

A forensic postmortem examination and routine toxicology testing is to be completed in the coming days. The cause and manner of death will be pending the conclusion of the investigation being completed by the California Highway Patrol- Marin Office and the Marin County Sheriff's Office - Coroner Division. No further information will be released by the Coroner Division at this time, as this is an active and ongoing investigation.
