Arrest Made in Burglary / Theft of Gun and Stolen Vehicle Investigation

San Rafael, CA – On May 4, 2009, a Marshall resident reported a burglary at his residence. A .357 revolver and various tools were taken from the victim's unlocked storage shed during the night. In addition, the victim's purple 1995 Ford F150 pick-up truck was stolen from his driveway. A credit card that the victim left inside the truck was also stolen.

During the investigation, detectives identified a male subject and a female subject associated with the subsequent use of the victim's stolen credit card.

While in the area of the Montecito Plaza shopping center in San Rafael at about 3:10 PM on May 8, 2009, two off-duty Sheriff's detectives observed a subject who matched the description of the male suspect involved in the unauthorized usage of the victim's stolen credit card. The detectives also located the victim's stolen purple pick-up truck parked in the shopping center's parking lot. While investigating further, the detectives also recognized a woman in the shopping center as another involved party.

Detectives detained both subjects and took them into custody.

While recovering the stolen truck, detectives located the victim's identification and checkbook inside the truck. Detectives are still actively working this investigation in order to determine the whereabouts of the stolen revolver.

James Risenhoover, 31 years old from Rodeo, CA, was booked at the Marin County Jail on charges of residential burglary, possession of a stolen vehicle, receiving stolen property and possession of drug paraphernalia. The woman was released pending further investigation.
