**Sheriff's Office Investigates Shooting in Marin City**

Marin City, CA- On May 16, 2009 at 1:01 AM, the Marin County Sheriff's Office Communications Center received a 9-1-1 call from a Marin City resident reporting that her neighbor had just been shot. Sheriff's deputies responded to the area and arrived on scene at 1:03 AM. Deputies located the victim in his apartment at 69 Cole Drive. The victim had a gunshot wound on the right side of his upper body near his back. The victim was transported by ambulance to a local hospital where he underwent emergency surgery.

Detectives from the Sheriff's Office continued the investigation. It appears that the victim was shot as he walked from the area of 49 Cole Drive toward his apartment at 69 Cole Drive just shortly before 1:00 AM. As he was walking, he heard someone call out to him. He looked in the direction of the voice, saw two black males, heard a gunshot and discovered he had been shot. The victim then ran to his apartment.

One suspect has been described as a black male in his late teens / early 20s, 5'6" to 5'9" tall, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt. The second suspect is described as a black male in his late teens / early 20s, approximately 6'0" tall and also wearing a black hooded sweatshirt.

The caliber of the firearm is undetermined.

Sheriff's detectives have interviewed some persons who were in the area at the time of the shooting.
