Suspect Arrested after Pistol-Whipping Victim in Marin City

Marin City, CA- On June 1, 2009 at about 7:50 AM, deputies from the Marin County Sheriff's Office contacted a 15 year old robbery victim who reported he was robbed at gun point and beaten in the 200 block of Drake Avenue in Marin City. The victim was transported to Kaiser Hospital, where he was treated and released for injuries he received after being pistol-whipped by an unknown black male suspect in his mid-twenties. Deputies later identified the suspect as Deandre Williams, 25, a parolee with an address in San Francisco.

At about 4:15 PM, sheriff's detectives located and arrested Williams while he was walking on Fillmore Street in San Francisco.

Detectives believe that today's robbery is connected to last night's failed drug deal in the 200 lot of Drake Avenue, where four shots were fired at an occupied vehicle leaving the area. That incident is still under investigation, but it is believed that some of the same persons are involved in both crimes.

Williams was transported back to Marin where he will be booked for robbery and assault charges.
