**Two Arrested in Residential Burglary**

San Rafael, CA – On October 21, 2009 at about 2:30 PM, a Santa Venetia resident was awoken from a nap by a doorbell ring at his front door. After a second ring, the resident looked outside and saw a subject jump over the fence into the resident's back yard. The victim then heard his kitchen door open at the back of his house and subsequently found the subject inside his house. When confronted by the resident, the subject fled on foot. A witness saw another subject coming out of a neighbor's yard. Both subjects fled the area in a red Toyota Corolla.

Sheriff's deputies responding to the call saw the vehicle leaving the area and both subjects were taken into custody.

Nothing was taken from the victim's residence. However, several burglary tools were located in the suspect's vehicle, along with computer keyboards and a cell phone.

San Rafael resident Frank Lavin, 19, and Bolinas resident Jeremiah Johnson, 19, were booked into the Marin County Jail on charges of burglary and possession of burglary tools. Their bail is \$50,000 each and they have a court appearance on October 22, 2009 at 1:30 PM in Marin Superior Court, Department M.
