Man Arrested in Mill Valley after Being Subdued by TASER Device

Mill Valley, CA – On November 9, 2009 at about 8:19 PM, sheriff's deputies were called by the innkeeper to America's Best Value Inn on Shoreline Highway in Mill Valley to investigate a domestic battery. Deputies located a woman and found evidence that she had been struck and bitten in the face. The woman stated that the suspect broke out the windshield of her vehicle, which prevented her from leaving, and removed the telephone to prevent her from calling law enforcement authorities.

Deputies located the suspect, Daniel Jordan, inside the bathroom of the hotel room. Jordan refused to cooperate with the deputies and their investigation. After taking a fighting stance, Jordan was subdued by the use of the TASER electronic control device and subsequently taken into custody. Jordan was medically cleared at Marin General Hospital and then booked at the Marin County Jail on charges of domestic violence, false imprisonment, injuring a telephone line and vandalism.

Jordan, a 31 year old Mill Valley resident, is being held on \$25,000 bail and is scheduled to appear in court today at 1:30 PM in Department M of the Marin County Superior Court.
