**Woman Arrested after Auto Burglary**

Fairfax, CA – On November 23, 2009 at about 9 PM, sheriff's deputies were called to investigate an auto burglary that had occurred in front of the Marin County Jail. One of the vehicle's windows was smashed and the victim's purse was stolen. The victim later reported that her credit card had been used at several different locations throughout Marin.

During the investigation, sheriff's detectives identified a suspect, Robyn Ring, and connected Ring to the fraudulent use of the victim's credit card. During a search of Ring's residence, detectives located a laptop computer that had been stolen in another auto burglary, as well as narcotics and narcotic paraphernalia.

On December 2, 2009, Ring, a 41 year old resident of Fairfax, was arrested and booked at the Marin County Jail on charges of possession of stolen property, unlawful use of a credit card, burglary, possession of a controlled substance for sale and possession of narcotic paraphernalia. Detectives determined that Ring had been released from jail on bail for a previous burglary case, so Ring was also booked for a charge of committing an offense while out on bail.

Ring is scheduled to appear in court on December 17, 2009 at 10:30 PM in department M. She is being held on \$25,000 bail for the new charges and \$40,000 for the case involving her previous release on bail.
