Two Juveniles Arrested in Thefts from Vehicles in San Geronimo Valley

Woodacre, CA – On August 10, 2010 at about 1130 PM, the Marin County Sheriff's Office received a call from a Woodacre resident who heard her dog barking, looked out and saw a male juvenile attempting to enter her vehicle. A motion light came on and the juvenile fled on foot toward Railroad Avenue. The resident provided a description of the suspect, stating he was wearing a black and white plaid shirt and jeans. Within ten minutes, deputies located two juveniles walking in the area of Railroad Avenue and San Geronimo Valley Road. One of the juveniles was wearing a black and white plaid shirt and jeans.

Both of the juveniles were arrested. One was booked at juvenile hall on charges of petty theft and possession of stolen property. The other juvenile was cited for vehicle tampering and released to his parents.

A large amount of property was recovered, including cell phones, an MP3 player, a Walkman, pocket knives, sunglasses, two men's watches, an emblem from a Volvo automobile, cigarette lighters and a large number of U.S. coins.

It appears as if the thefts occurred from a significant number of unlocked vehicles. The sheriff's office would like to remind our residents to help prevent theft by locking their vehicles, especially when the vehicles are left unattended.
