INMATE SHOWERS

POLICY

It is the policy of the Marin County Sheriff's Office to provide adequate time and proper facilities for all inmates housed at the Marin County Jail to maintain personal hygiene while in custody. Showers will be open and available to all inmates during their recreation time.

PROCEDURE

Inmates will be encouraged to shower and maintain personal hygiene while in custody.

Inmates will be allowed to shower on their recreation time. Inmates are to wear their complete issued uniform while walking to and from the showers. Inmates are required to bring their issued towel to the shower area. Only one inmate will be allowed in a shower stall at a time.

The showers will be cleaned and disinfected daily by Pod inmate workers, who will insure that all showers are adequately supplied with soap/shampoo.

Inmates housed in the Lockdown Pod will be allowed to shower during their one hour and fifteen minute recreation time, which is provided to them every other day. All shower rules and standards will apply to inmates housed in the Lockdown Pod.
